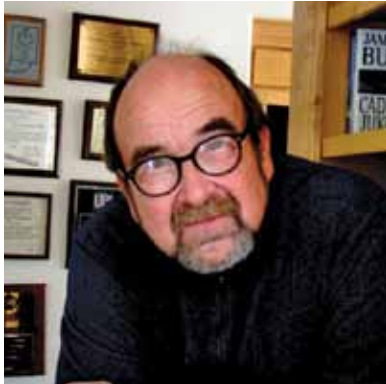

Dan Luzadder is a writer and investigative reporter whose work has appeared in the *New York Times*, *New York Daily News*, the *Chicago Tribune* and other major U.S. newspapers and magazines. He spent more than 30 years in daily journalism before working as a senior writer for two east coast magazines and moving on to full-time freelance writing. He is a former investigative reporter for the *Rocky Mountain News*, a member of the investigative team of the *Indianapolis Star*, and a former columnist for the *Fort Wayne (Indiana) News Sentinel*.

Dan shared a Pulitzer Prize in 1983 for general local reporting, an American Bar Association Award for Public Service and is a member of the Scripps Howard Journalism Hall of Fame. His work has produced more than two dozen awards for public service journalism, and for writing and reporting. He lives in Evergreen with his wife Nancy and their two children, who are students at Mullen High School and St. Mary's Academy.

In addition to his contributions to TEN | 10 Group, Dan is a U.S. correspondent for a London-based financial wire service, conducts private investigations into matters of public interest, and is at work on a book about the Chicago mob. A dedicated reader of crime novels, he is also a long-time youth baseball coach, a volunteer story-teller at area schools and a long-suffering Indiana University basketball fan. In the long season, he cheers for the Colorado Rockies—and the Boston Red Sox.
